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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

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AN ACT to amend section nine of chapter thirty of the revised statutes.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section nine of chapter thirty of the revised statutes  
2 is hereby amended so as to read as follows :

3   *Sect. 9.* No person shall hunt or kill on any land  
4 in this state any moose, deer or caribou from the first  
5 day of January to the first day of October, under a  
6 penalty of forty dollars for each moose, deer or caribou  
7 so killed ; any person may lawfully shoot or otherwise  
8 kill any dog found hunting moose, deer or caribou  
9 within the time or with the persons herein prohibited.
