STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter thirty-nine of the revised statutes relating to the inspection of lime.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The eighth and ninth lines of section one of chapter 2 thirty-nine of the revised statutes are hereby amended, 3 by striking out the words "Thomaston" and inserting 4 "Rockland," "ten" and inserting "five," "Warren" 5 and inserting "Thomaston," "five" and inserting 6 "three," so that said lines shall read as follows:

7 The inspector of Rockland, five thousand dollars;
8 of Thomaston and Camden, three thousand each, and
9 of every other town.
