## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT relating to penalties of selectmen or assessors for malfeasance in office.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section fifty-two of chapter four of the revised stat-

- 2 utes, is hereby amended, by inserting after the word
- 3 "twenty-two" in said section of said chapter, the fol-
- 4 lowing words, viz: "or wilfully and fraudulently
- 5 receive the vote of any person not qualified to be an
- 6 elector, as provided by the constitution," so that said
- 7 section fifty-two of said chapter four shall read, when
- 8 so amended, as follows:
- 9 "Sect. 52. If such selectmen or assessors wilfully
- 10 neglect or refuse to keep and use a check list, as pro-
- 11 vided in section twenty-one, or wilfully receive any
- 12 vote prohibited by section twenty-two, or wilfully and

- 13 fraudulently receive the vote of any person not quali-
- 14 fied to be an elector, as provided by the constitution,
- 15 they shall each forfeit not less than fifty nor more than
- 16 one hundred dollars"
