STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to amend chapter sixty-three of the revised statutes, relating to notices in probate courts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. In all laws relating to probate courts

- 2 and proceedings, the words, "public notice," denote
- 3 notice published three weeks successively in a news-
- 4 paper printed in the county, or, if none, in the state
- 5 paper; the words, "personal notice," denote service
- 6 by a copy given in hand or left at the place of last
- 7 and usual abode seven days at least before the time of
- 8 hearing; and the words, "due notice," denote public
- 9 or personal notice at the discretion of the judge.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
