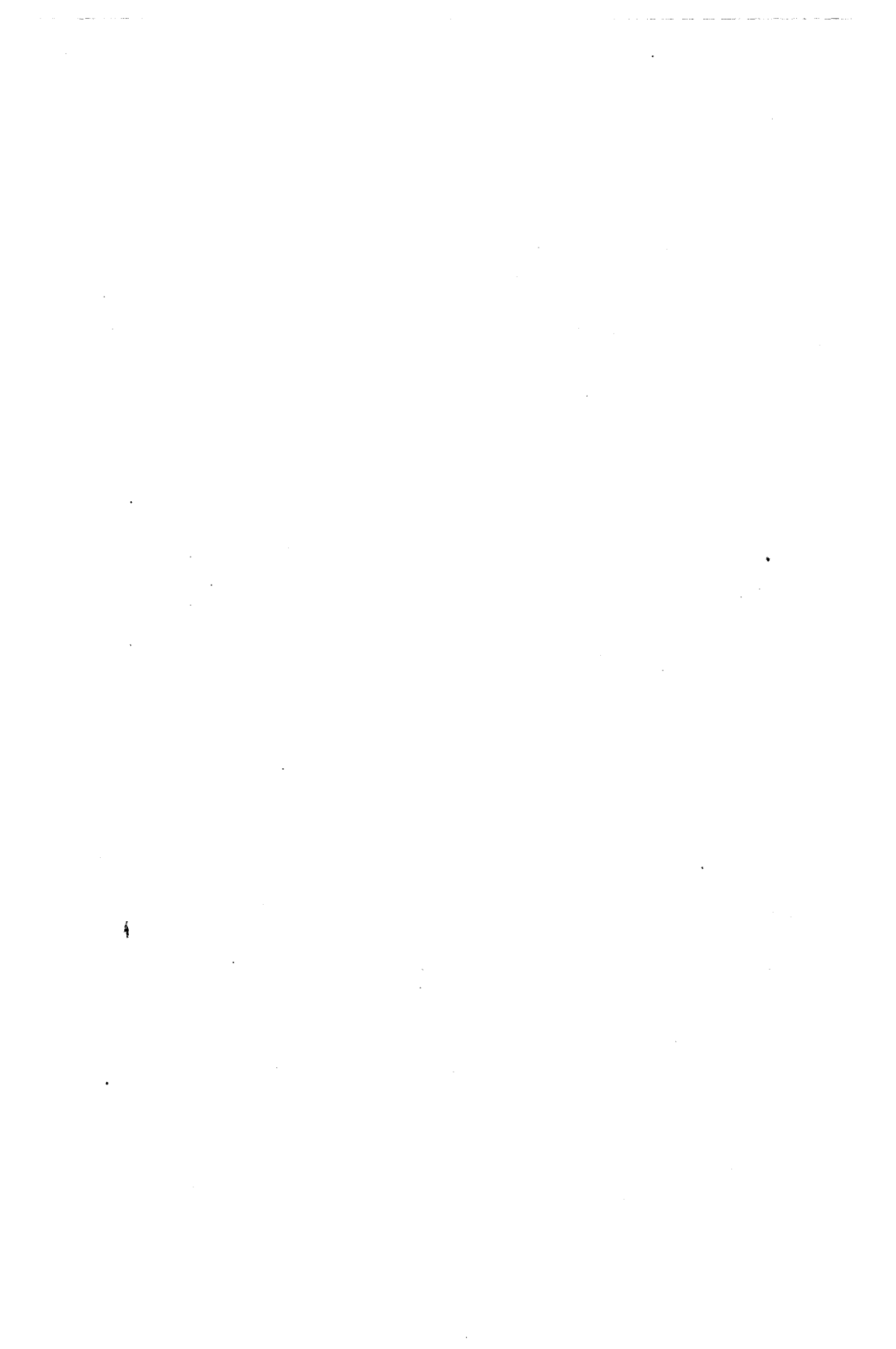
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to amend chapter sixty-three of the revised statutes, relating to notices in probate courts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. In all laws relating to probate courts and proceedings, the words, "public notice," denote notice published three weeks successively in a newspaper printed in the county, or, if none, in the state paper; the words, "personal notice," denote service by a copy given in hand or left at the place of last and usual abode seven days at least before the time of hearing; and the words, "due notice," denote public or personal notice at the discretion of the judge.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
