IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT additional to chapter forty-eight of the revised statutes, concerning manufactures.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

For abutting dams to raise a head of water, and for

- 2 cutting canals and sluices to operate machinery for
- 3 manufacturing purposes, land may be taken and held
- 4 as for public uses, subject to all the proceedings and
- 5 remedies for the estimation, payment and recovery of
- 6 damages therefor provided in case of lands taken for
- 7 railroads.
