STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to establish certain rules for the construction of statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. In the construction of all statutes here-2 after enacted, the following rules shall be observed, 3 unless such construction would be repugnant to the 4 express terms of the same statute, that is to say:

5 *First*—The repeal of an act or resolve shall not 6 revive any statute in force before the act or resolve 7 repealed took effect.

8 Second—The repeal of an act shall not affect any 9 punishment, penalty or forfeiture incurred before the 10 repeal takes effect, or any suit or prosecution or pro-

11 ceeding pending at the time of the repeal for an 12 offence committed or for the recovery of a penalty or 13 forfeiture incurred under the act repealed.

SECT. 2. Actions pending at the time of the passage 2 or repeal of an act shall not be affected thereby.
