STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The road from Patten was laid out by the County Commissioners, and crosses Fish stream in Island Falls plantation where a bridge will be necessary, as the numerous streams which fall into the Mattawamkeag lake pass through said plantation, the necessity for building and maintaining so many bridges imposes a burden on the scattered inhabitants that they are unable to bear. It is estimated that the bridge above named will cost about \$600. The road is the one mentioned by the Commissioners on the Settlement of Public Lands.

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of building a bridge over Fish stream in Island Falls plantation.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars be

- 3 under the direction of the land agent, to aid in build-

- 5 tion, to be paid when said bridge is completed.
