STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This road was laid out by the State and passes through State lands, and is about ten miles in length, and when opened will complete the line of road from the Schoodic lakes to the St. John's river in northern Aroostook. It is the same piece of road mentioned in the Report of the Commissioners on the Settlement of the Public Lands.

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of opening a road through letters F and
G, range one, Aroostook county.

Resolved, That the sum of six hundred dollars be,
2 and the same is hereby appropriated, to aid in opening
3 a road from the north line of Limestone through letters
4 F and G, range one; to be expended under the direc-
5 tion of the land agent.
