AMENDMENT TO BILL CONCERNING INTEREST.

"A."

Section one of chapter forty-five of the revised statutes is amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. Legal interest upon the loan or forbear-

- 2 ance of any money, goods, merchandise or things in
- 3 action is hereby established at the rate of six dollars
- 4 on a hundred dollars for one year; but the parties
- 5 may agree in writing to a different rate, and the rate
- 8 so agreed upon shall be legal. The foregoing rules
- a shall not apply to letting cattle, or other similar con-
- 10 tracts in practice among farmers, or to maintain con-
- 11 tracts, as bottomy, insurance and course of exchange,
- 12 in practice among merchants.
