STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to authorize cities and towns to aid in promoting manufactures therein.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Any city or town, by a two-thirds vote,

- 2 at any legal meeting called for the purpose, may raise
- 3 by tax or loan, from time to time or all at once, a sum
- 4 of money not exceeding in all five per cent. on its
- 5 regular valuation for the time being, and appropriate
- 6 the same to aid in promoting manufactures therein;
- 7 and for such purpose may make contracts with any
- 8 persons or corporations.
 - SECT. 2. When such city or town holds stock in
- 2 any manufacturing corporation, the municipal officers

- 3 thereof, or an agent appointed by them in writing,
- 4 may vote thereon at any meeting of the corporation.
 - SECT. 3. A city or town raising money by loan as
- 2 aforesaid, shall raise and pay, each year after the
- 3 third, in addition to the interest, not less than three
- 4 per cent. of the principal, unless it is provided for in
- 5 some other way.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
