STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to increase the compensation of members of the legislature.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. From and after the first Wednesday of 2 January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight 3 hundred and seventy-one, the compensation of mem- 4 bers of the senate and house of representatives shall 5 be three hundred dollars for attendance at each regular 6 session of the legislature instead of the sum now fixed 7 by law; and the compensation of the president of the 8 senate and the speaker of the house of representatives 9 for their services at such sessions shall be four hundred 10 dollars instead of the sums now allowed them by law.

SECT. 2. Their compensation for travel at every session of the legislature and for attendance at extra sessions shall remain as now fixed by law.
