STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and thirty of the public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-four relating to evidence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and thirty of the 2 public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-four is 3 amended so as to read as follows:

4 In an action by or against an executor, administra-5 tor or other legal representative of a deceased person, 6 in which his account books or other memoranda are 7 used as evidence on either side, the other party may 8 testify in relation thereto.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
