STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and sixty-four of the public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, relating to the distribution of lists of magistrates.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section one of chapter two hundred and sixty-four is amended so as to read as follows :

3 *Sect. 1.* The secretary of state shall, on or before
4 the first day of June next, forward to the clerks of
5 courts and registers of probate in the several counties,
6 a list of all justices of the peace, justices of the peace
7 and quorum, trial justices and notaries public in this
8 state, whose commission shall then be in force, and the
9 evidence of whose qualifications has been filed in his

10 office. Such list shall contain the name and place of
11 residence of every such officer, the date of his com-
12 mission, and the county or counties for which he is
13 commissioned. And he shall forward to said clerks
14 and registers on the first day of December and of June
15 annually thereafter, a similar list of all such officers
16 commissioned and qualified during each preceding
17 period of six months.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
