STATEMENT OF FACTS.

It appears by the Land Office Records, that William Brown of Township No. 16, R. 7, was entitled to a deed of two lots of land in said township under the treaty of Washington, and for which the State has received payment from the General Government. It also appears by the receipt of C. K. Eddy, Dept. Land Agent, that the said Brown paid to him April 24, 1858, the sum of \$25.00 for stumpage of pine timber cut upon said lots; and by the receipt of Henry Clark, Dept. Agent, the said Brown paid the further sum of \$63.28 for stumpage cut upon said lots in the winter of 1861; to all of which the said William Brown was justly entitled by the terms of said treaty. The said sums, with the interest thereon, amount to the total sum of one hundred thirty-six dollars and thirty cents.

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to refund money to William Brown paid the state for stumpage.

Resolved, That there be refunded to William Brown 2 the sum of one hundred thirty-six dollars and thirty 3 cents, being the amount received from him by the 4 state in payment of money paid deputy land agents 5 C. K. Eddy and Henry Clark for timber cut on his 6 two lots of land granted to him under the treaty of 7 Washington, which sum is to be paid out of the 8 treasury from any funds not otherwise appropriated, 9 and to be in full payment of all money or stumpage 10 of timber advanced to the state, and interest on the 11 same, and the governor is hereby authorized to draw 12 his warrant on the treasury for the same.
