STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT relating to the reduction of poll taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and ninety-one of
- 2 the public laws of eighteen hundred sixty-five, chapter
- 3 two hundred and fifty-one of public laws of eighteen
- 4 hundred sixty-four, and section twenty-eight of chap-
- 5 ter six of the revised statutes, are hereby repealed.
 - Sect. 2. In the assessment of all state, county, town,
- 2 plantation, parish or society taxes, the assessors thereof
- 3 shall govern themselves by the rules contained in chap-
- 4 ter six of the revised statutes until otherwise provided
- 5 by the legislature, except in parishes and societies
- 6 where a different provision for assessing their taxes is
- 7 made, and shall assess on the taxable polls one-eighth

- 8 part as nearly as may be of the whole sum to be raised;
- 9 but the whole poll tax assessed in one year upon an .
- 10 individual for town, county and state purposes except
- 11 highway taxes, shall not exceed two dollars. The same
- 12 rule shall be observed in the assessment of highway
- 13 taxes; and the residue of such taxes shall be assessed
- 14 on the estates according to their value.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect on approval.
