## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to amend section ten of chapter eighty-seven of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section ten of chapter eighty-seven of 2 the revised statutes, is amended, to read as follows:

3 Sect. 10. When either of several plaintiffs or de-4 fendants in an action that survives, dies, the death 5 may be suggested on the record, and the executor or 6 administrator of the deceased may appear, or be cited 7 to appear, as provided in section seven; and the 8 action may be further prosecuted or defended by the 9 survivors, and such executor or administrator, jointly 10 or by either of them; and judgment may be entered 11 against the survivors, and also against the goods and

12 estate of the deceased in the hands of such executor13 or administrator, and a joint execution issued.

SECT. 2. This act takes effect when approved by 2 the governor.
