STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to prohibit the wholesale destruction of waterfowl by traps, etc.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. If any person or persons shall trap,
- 2 snare or capture wild ducks of any variety, other than
- 3 in the usual manner of sporting with fire-arms, within
- 4 the limits of the state, shall forfeit and pay for each
- 5 duck so taken a sum not less than two dollars nor
- 6 more than five, to be recovered by action of trespass,
- 7 half to the use of town or plantation in which the
- 8 offence is committed, the other half to the person com-
- 9 plaining.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
