STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Molunkus bridge was built by the United States, and was finally turned over, together with the Military Road and all other bridges on the same, to the State of Maine, the State being under obligation to keep the same in repair. This one, the Molunkus, needs rebuilding, except the abutments. The appropriation made in 1869 was not sufficient, therefore a further appropriation is recommended by the Committee.

5 military road.
