STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter thirty-four of the revised statutes, relating to licensing auctioneers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter three of the
2 revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the
3 words "in such town and," in the third line thereof,
4 and the words "other" "where there is no licensed
5 auctioneer," in the fourth line thereof, so that said
6 section shall read as follows :

7 *Section 1.* The municipal officers of any town may
8 license any suitable inhabitant of their county, by a
9 writing under their hands, to be auctioneer for one
10 year in any town in said county ; and shall record
11 every such license in a book kept by them for that
12 purpose.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
