STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing a commission to inquire into the jail system of this state.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Resolved, That the governor, with the advice and

- 2 consent of the council, is hereby authorized to appoint
- 3 a commission of three suitable persons, whose duty
- 4 shall be to examine into and investigate the present
- 5 jail system of this state, and report to the next legis-
- 6 lature what reform in the same, if any, may seem to
- 7 them judicious and wise. The said examination and
- 8 investigation shall be pursued in accordance with in-
- 9 structions to be given by the governor and council,
- 10 who shall also fix the compensation of the commis-
- 11 sioners, and the governor shall draw his warrant for
- 12 the payment of the same.
