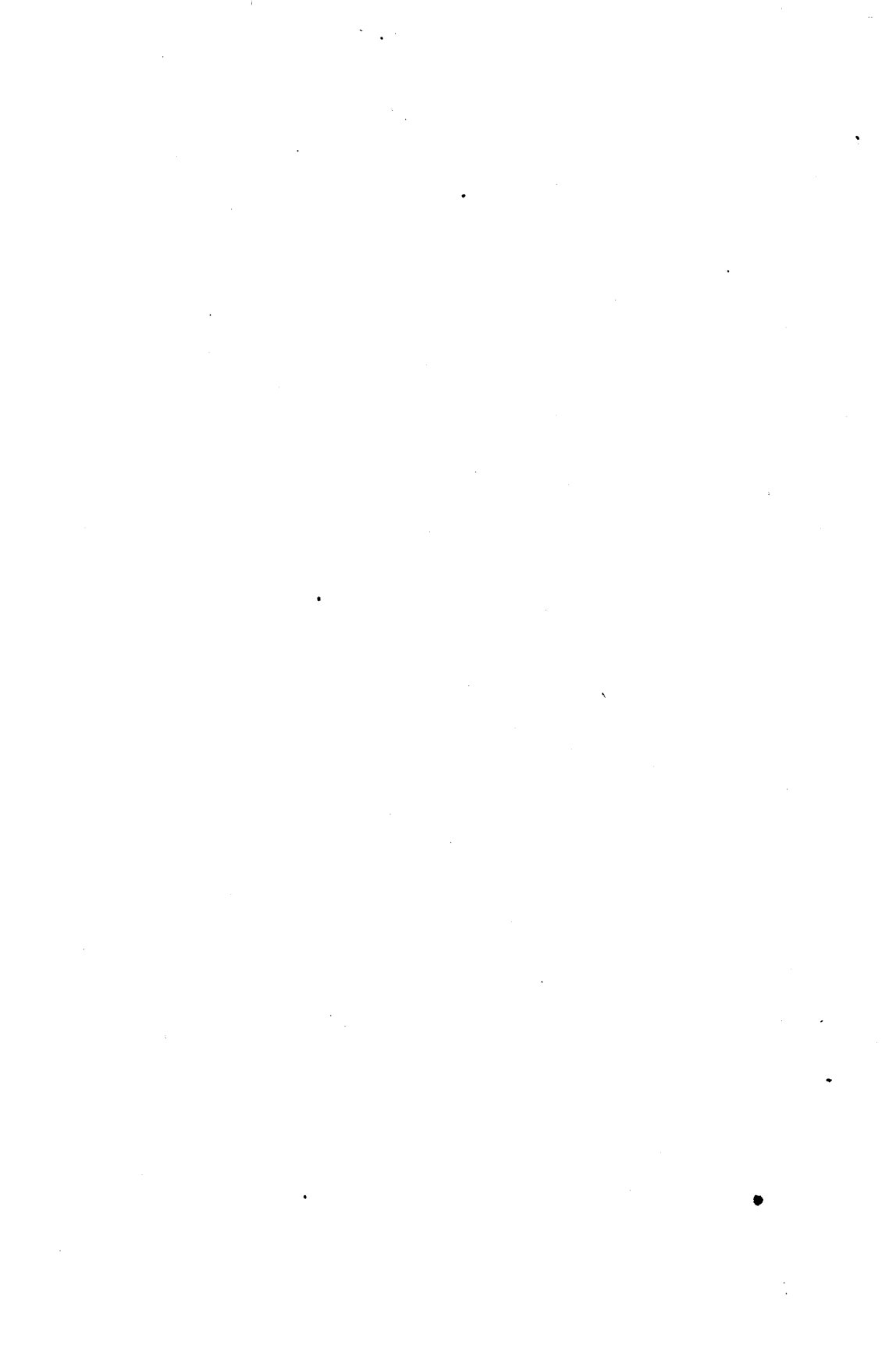
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT relating to evidence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. That copies of all papers and documents
2 belonging to or filed or remaining in the office of any
3 consul, vice consul, or commercial agent of the United
4 States, and of all official entries in the books or records
5 of any such office, shall, when certified under the hand
6 and official seal of the proper consul, vice consul or
7 commercial agent, be admissible in evidence.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
