STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT additional to and amendatory of an act establishing the times of holding the several terms of the supreme judicial court, approved February twenty-eight, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. In addition to the terms now prescribed
2 by law, the supreme judicial court shall be held annu-
3 ally, by one of the justices thereof, in the county of
4 Oxford, at Paris, on the third Tuesday of December.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
