## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to amend the eighth section of chapter one hundred and ninety-one of the public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The eighth section of chapter one hun-2 dred and ninety-one of the public laws of eighteen 3 hundred and sixty-eight is hereby amended by substi-4 tuting June for July in the first line of said section, 5 so that as amended said section shall read as follows, 6 to wit:

7 "If by the fifteenth day of June following in each 8 year, the owners of such lands shall repair such roads 9 to the acceptance of the commissioners, after an actual 10 examination by one or more of their board, the assess-

11 ment shall be thereby discharged, otherwise it shall be12 enforced as hereinafter provided, and the agents shall13 proceed immediately to repair such roads."

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
