
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT amendatory of an act establishing the times of holding the several terms of the supreme judicial court, approved February twenty-eighth, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The supreme judicial court shall be held 2 on the second Tuesdays of April and October in each 3 year, at Ellsworth, within and for the county of Han-4 cock, instead of the fourth Tuesdays of said months, 5 as is now provided by law. And all writs, processes 6 and proceedings, returnable on said fourth Tuesdays 7 of April and October, shall be entered and have day 8 on the second Tuesdays of said months.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
