STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making an appropriation for the Penobscot tribe of Indians.

Resolved, That there be paid from the state treasury, 2 to the agent of the Penobscot tribe of Indians, to be 3 appropriated for the benefit of said tribe, as follows: 4 four hundred dollars shall be expended for schools, viz., 5 two hundred dollars on Oldtown island, under the 6 supervision of the superintending school committee of 7 Oldtown; one hundred and twenty dollars on Matta-8 nawcook island, under the supervision of the superin-9 tending school committee of Lincoln; and eighty 10 dollars on Olamon island, under the supervision of the 11 superintending school committee of Greenbush; and 12 said committees are required to report as directed by a 13 resolve approved March seventeenth, eighteen hundred 14 and sixty, and it is made the duty of the agent of said

15 tribe to see that said money is fully expended for the 16 education of the children of said tribe; one thousand 17 dollars shall be expended for agricultural purposes; 18 five hundred dollars for bounties on crops; three hun-19 dred dollars for salary of the agent of said tribe; one 20 hundred and fifty dollars for salary of superintendent 21 of farming on same conditions as required by chapter 22 ninety-six of the private resolves of eighteen hundred 23 sixty-seven; thirty dollars for salary of the governor 24 of said tribe, and thirty dollars for the salary of the 25 lieutenant governor; fifty dollars for salary of priest, 26 provided that he administer ten masses or more; two 27 thousand dollars for the usual annuity.

Resolved, That there shall also be paid to said Penob-2 scot tribe of Indians thirty-five hundred forty-four 3 dollars forty-eight cents, being interest on the trust 4 fund held by the state for the benefit of said tribe, two 5 hundred dollars of which may be expended by the 6 Indian agent in repairing church on Oldtown island if 7 necessary, and the balance to be expended under the 8 direction of the governor and council.
