STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to amend section sixty-five, chapter four of the revised statutes, relating to penalty for illegal voting.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section sixty-five of chapter four of the
2 revised statutes, is hereby amended, by inserting after
3 the word " county " the words " or municipal, " so
4 so that the section, as amended, shall read as follows :
5 *Sect. 65.* If a person, at an election of state and
6 county or municipal officers, or of electors of president
7 and vice president, knowingly votes in any city, town
8 or plantation, where he has no legal right to vote, he
9 shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail
10 not less than three months, nor more than one year.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
