STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to amend the twenty-second section of the eleventh chapter of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The twenty-second section of the eleventh chapter of
2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding the
3 following item after the fifth item in said section, viz :
4 *Sixth*—To allow the school house to be used for
5 meetings of religious worship, lectures, and other
6 similar purposes.
