STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to amend section nine of chapter seven of the revised statutes, relating to changing the registry district of Aroostook county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section nine of the seventh chapter of 2 the revised statutes shall be, and hereby is, so far 3 altered and amended as to read as follows :

4 *Sect. 9.* All that part of the county of Aroostook 5 lying north of a line commencing in the southeast 6 corner of township F, in the first range west from the 7 east line of the state ; thence west on the south line of 8 said township and the south line of township K, in 9 the second range, to township numbered fifteen in the 10 third range ; thence south to the northeast corner of

11 township numbered thirteen in the third range ; thence
12 west on the dividing line of townships thirteen and
13 fourteen, to the seventh range line ; thence north to
14 the northeast corner of township numbered thirteen in
15 the eighth range ; thence west to the west line of the
16 state, shall compose the northern registry district of
17 Aroostook county, and the register shall keep his office
18 in the town of Madawaska, in said district.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
2 the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its approval.
