STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT to authorize the treasurer of the state to issue registered bonds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The treasurer of this state is hereby
- 2 authorized to issue registered bonds, transferable by
- 3 assignment, in pieces of not less than one thousand
- 4 dollars, and of any multiple of one thousand, in ex-
- 5 change for, and in lieu of, any coupon bonds which
- 6 have been issued under the laws of this state, bearing
- 7 the same rate of interest and maturing at the same
- 8 time as the bonds which he may receive therefor in
- 9 exchange, but the place of payment prescribed therein
- 10 shall be the state treasury, and not elsewhere; and
- 11 the said bonds shall be signed by the treasurer,

5 therefor.

- 12 countersigned by the governor, and attested by the 13 secretary of state, with the seal of the state.
 - SECT. 2. Upon due assignment of any such 2 registered bond and delivery thereof to the state treas-3 urer, an equivalent bond or bonds, in form as afore-4 said shall be issued to the assignee in substitution
 - Sect. 3. All bonds received by the treasurer for 2 exchange under the provisions of this act, shall be 3 effectually effaced and cancelled, and retained in the 4 office of the treasurer, and the secretary of state as 5 well as the treasurer shall keep a register of all bonds 6 issued under the authority of this act, showing the 7 serial number, date and amount of each certificate, to 8 whom issued, when payable, and also a like description of the bonds received in lieu therefor.
 - Sect. 4. All coupon bonds issued by this state belonging to either of the sinking funds of this state may
 be converted into bonds registered in the name of the
 treasurer, and so much of the act approved February
 sixth, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, as relates to
 bonds belonging to said sinking funds, is hereby repealed; any coupon bonds issued by this state held
 by, or deposited with, the treasurer for trust purposes,
 may be converted into the registered form of bonds

- 10 hereby authorized, whenever the parties depositing 11 them shall desire it.
- SECT. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
