## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT additional to section fifty-two of chapter eighty of revised statutes, relating to sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section fifty-two of chapter eighty of revised statutes

- 2 is hereby amended by adding thereto as follows:
- 3 And no person employed by any sheriff, jailor, or
- 4 other person in charge of any prison, or jail, in this
- 5 state, in the capacity of turnkey, clerk, or in any other
- 6 capacity about such prison or jail, shall hereafter exer-
- 7 ciseany of the duties, powers, or privileges pertaining
- 8 to any magistrate of this state, nor act as attorney for
- 9 any person confined in such prison; and any such act,
- 10 so done by any such person in the capacity of such
- 11 magistrate or attorney, shall be void.
