STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

AN ACT relating to injunctions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Whenever a judge of the supreme judicial court shall

- 2 order a writ of attachment to be issued against any
- 3 person for contempt in refusing or neglecting to obey
- 4 any decree, decision or order of said court or of any
- 5 member thereof, returnable to the next term, and such
- 6 person has been arrested and given bail thereon, accord-
- 7 ing to the rules of said board for practice in chancery,
- 8 if such person shall afterwards, before the next term
- 9 of the court, again violate the said decree, order or
- 10 decision, a second writ of attachment may be issued,
- 11 upon proper proceedings therefor, returnable to the
- 12 next term, on which he shall not be bailable.
