IN SENATE, February 17, 1870.

Ordered, That the Land Agent be requested to inform the Legislature how many acres of land are now owned by the State and what proportion in acres is timber land, and what proportion is settling lands, so called, and what proportion is under contract for sale or conveyance; and if the public lots are all located and surveyed, together with such other information connected therewith as he may possess.
