STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT to make valid the transfer of the Bangor, Oldtown and Milford Railroad to the European and North American Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The sale and transfer of the franchise, 2 lands, property and rights, of the Bangor, Oldtown 3 and Milford Railroad Company, to the European and 4 North American Railway Company, is hereby author- 5 ized, ratified and confirmed, and said last named 6 company is authorized to purchase, hold, enjoy and 7 possess the same, as fully as said Bangor, Oldtown 8 and Milford Railroad Company could, and is entitled 9 to all the rights and privileges conferred by, and con- 10 tained in the charter of said Bangor, Oldtown and

11 Milford Railroad Company, and acts additional thereto,
12 which are contained in force for the benefit of said
13 European and North American Railway Company;
14 and said European and North American Railway Com-
15 pany may sell any of said lands and property, and use
16 the same, in the construction of its railroad, and any
17 and all transfer of shares of stock of said Bangor, Old-
18 town and Milford Railroad Company heretofore made
19 for that purpose is ratified and confirmed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
