STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT to revive and continue in force sections one to six inclusive, of chapter one hundred and seventy, public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "an act authorizing pensions for disabled soldiers and seamen."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The provisions of sections one, two, 2 three, four, five and six, of chapter one hundred and 3 seventy, public laws of eighteen hundred sixty-eight, 4 are hereby revived and continued in force for one year 5 from the thirty-first day of December, eighteen hun- 6 dred and seventy.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
