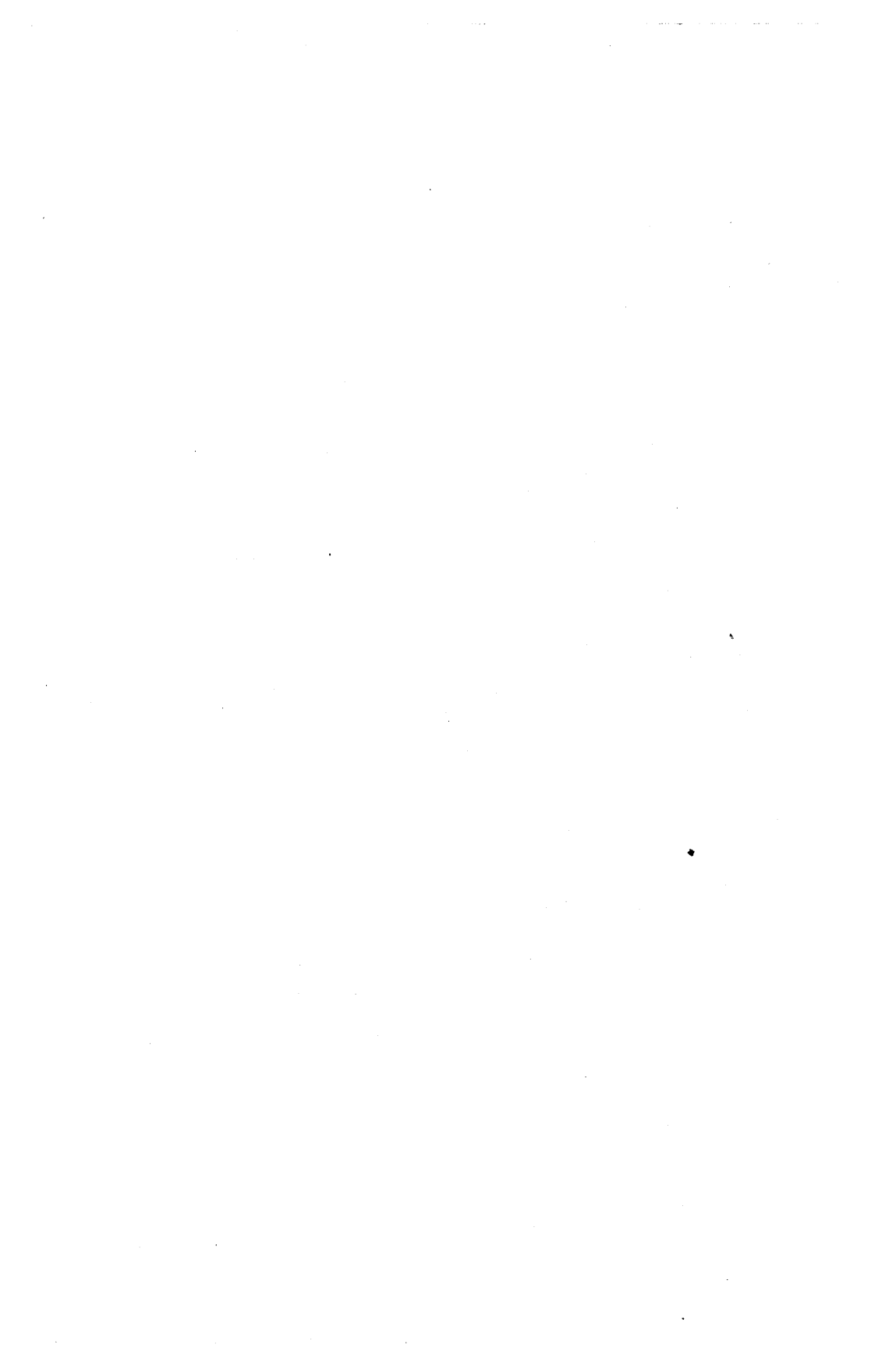

To the Speaker of the House of Representatives:

In response to the order of the House of Representatives this day passed, requesting the Secretary of State "to furnish for the information of the House the amount of the cost for the printing and binding of the report of the Secretary of the Board of Agriculture for the year 1869, printed in 1870," I have the honor to inform you that the records of this office show that there were printed of the above report twelve thousand copies at the cost of five thousand nine hundred and eight dollars and twenty-two cents; and that the binding of the same amounted to two thousand five hundred and eighty-six dollars and twenty-five cents, making the entire expense eight thousand four hundred and ninety-four dollars and forty-six cents.
