STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT authorizing towns, cities and village corporations to make by-laws and ordinances in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Towns, cities and village corporations
2 may make such by-laws and ordinances as they deem
3 proper, respecting the location and protection of trees,
4 lamp-posts, posts and hydrants within the limits of
5 their roads, ways and streets. And no trees, lamp-
6 posts, posts or hydrants which are now located or shall
7 hereafter be located in accordance with the require-
8 ments of such by-laws and ordinances shall be deemed
9 a defect in such road, way or street.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect at the time of its
2 approval by the governor.
