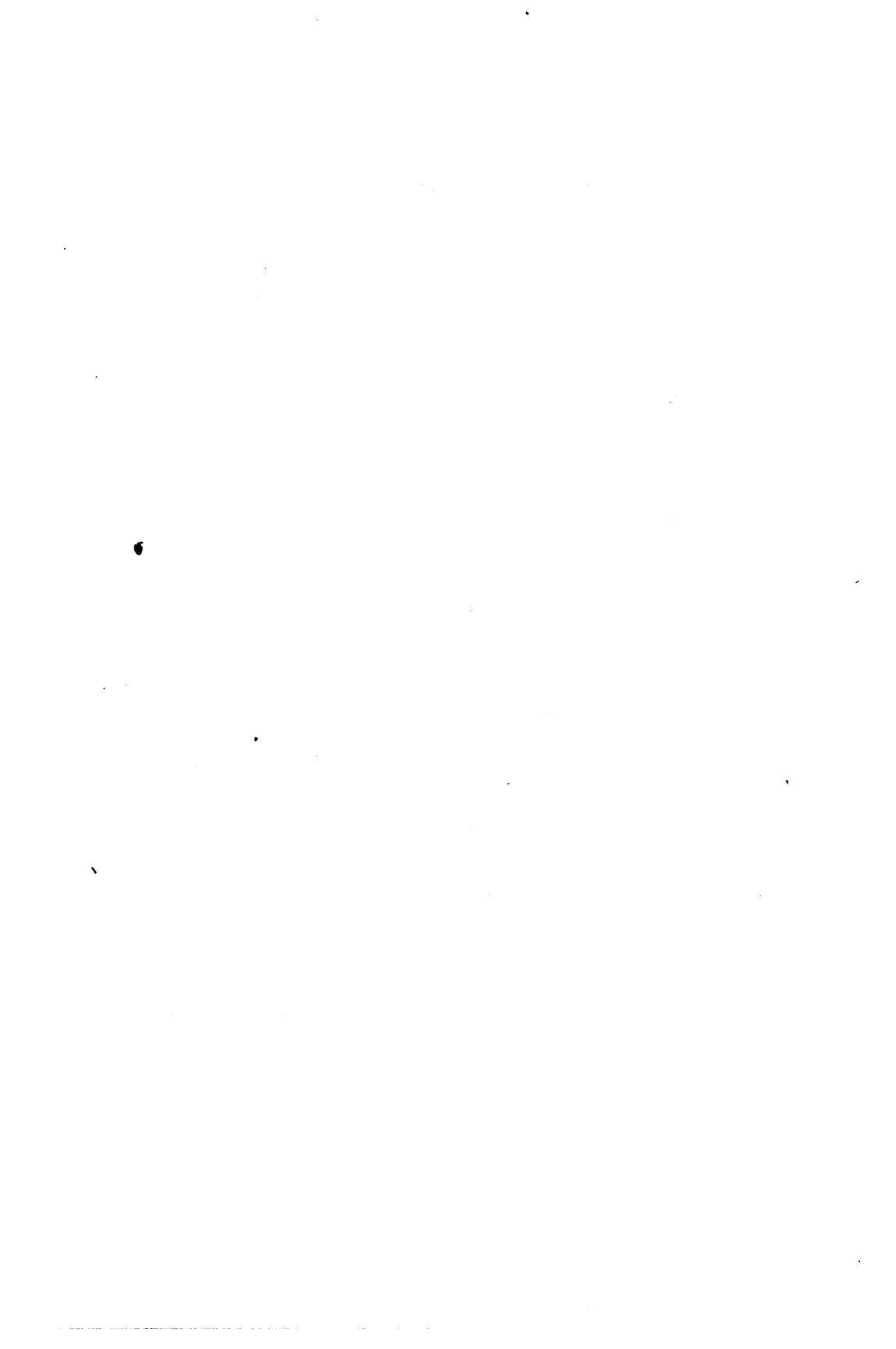

In the sixth section, after the words, "in order that all persons interested may have an opportunity to appear and object thereto," insert the following :

But no objection shall be considered conclusive, or
2 location refused, solely because said proposed railway
3 may run parallel to, or come in competition with, any
4 other existing or proposed railroad.
