STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-nine of chapter eighty-one of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section twenty-nine of chapter eighty-
2 one of the revised statutes is hereby amended, by
3 striking out the following words in the first line of
4 said section, "living animals, or goods," and inserting
5 instead the following words, "any personal property,"
6 so that said section as amended shall read as follows:
7 *Sect. 29.* When any personal property liable to
8 perish, be wasted, greatly reduced in value by keep-
9 ing, or kept at great expense, is attached, and the
10 parties do not consent to a sale thereof, the same may

11 be examined and appraised before or after the entry
12 of the action, as follows.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
