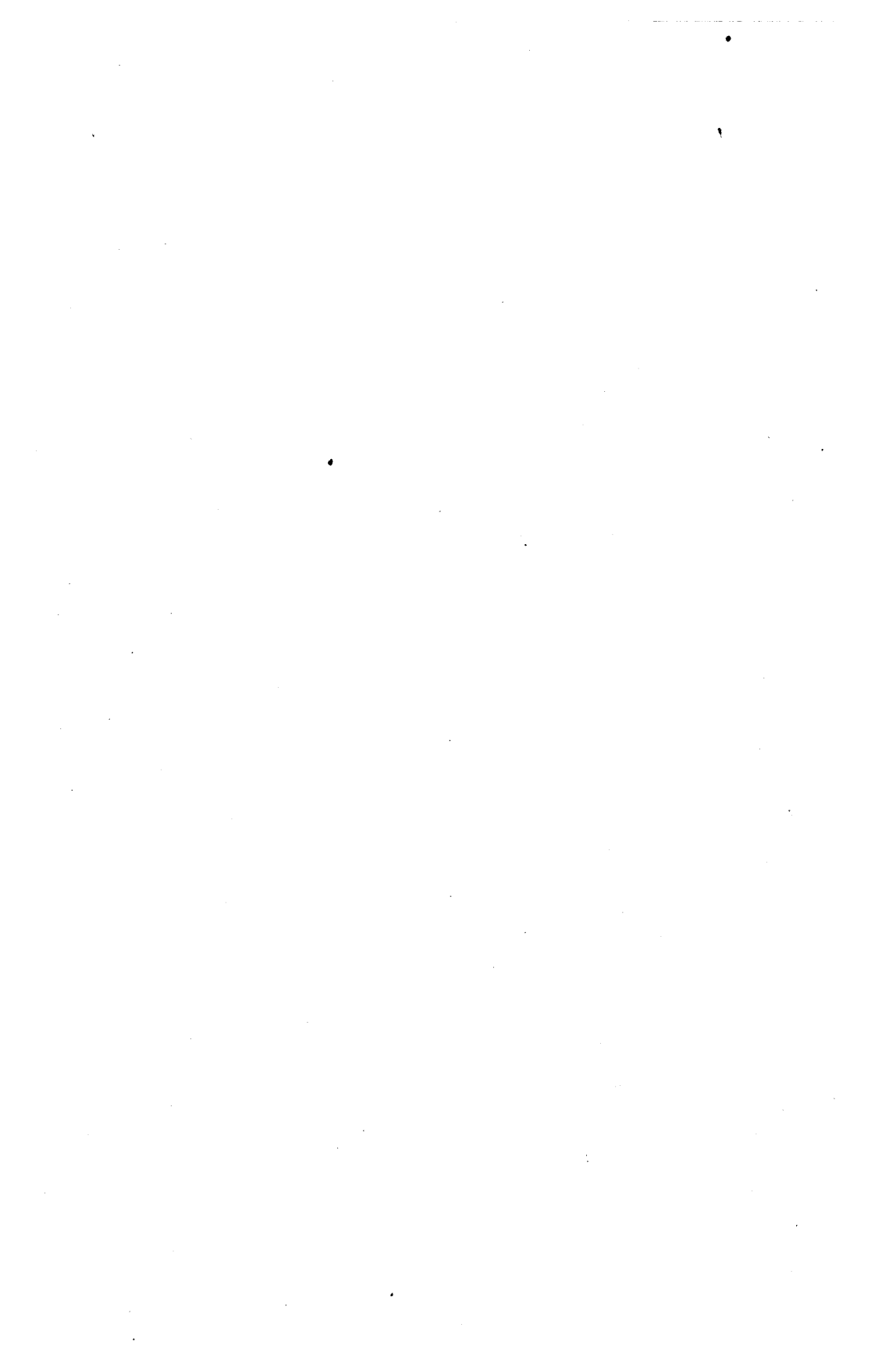
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT to increase the fees of town clerks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Town clerks shall receive for entering
2 and recording intentions of marriage, giving certificate
3 of same, and recording marriage on receiving the
4 minister's or justice's certificate thereof, one dollar,
5 instead of the sum now provided by law, to be paid on
6 issuing the certificate of intention of marriage.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
2 this act are repealed.
