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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

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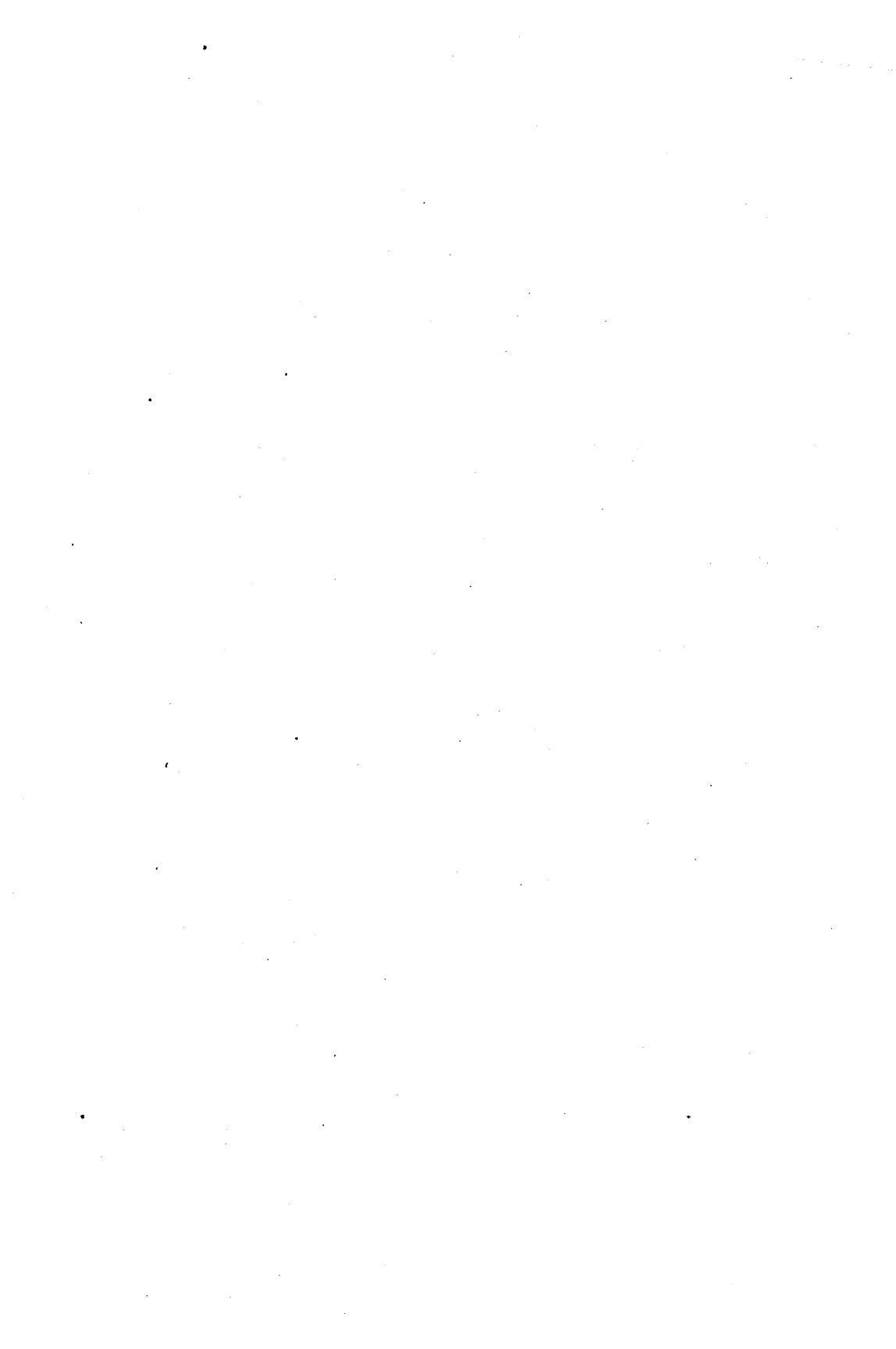
AN ACT to repeal section one, chapter one hundred and twenty of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy, relating to the taking of porgies or menhaden in the waters of Maine.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and 2 twenty of the public laws of eighteen hundred and 3 seventy is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
