STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT entitled an act to exempt females from arrest
for debt.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. No female shall hereafter be arrested
2 for debt.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect in sixty days
2 after its approval.
