STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT additional to “an act to provide for more free navigation of Penobscot river.”

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section first of said “act to provide for 2 more free navigation of Penobscot river,” is hereby 3 amended by adding thereto at the end of said section 4 as follows :

5 But when on account of a sudden rise of water, or 6 freshet, it is not practicable for said owners or occu- 7 pants of booms or saw-mills to maintain said shear 8 booms, and in such case logs or lumber enter their 9 booms and mill pounds, then the owners of said logs 10 and lumber are to remove the same at their own ex-

11 pense, and said owners and occupants of booms and
12 saw-mills shall not be liable for damages as above.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
