STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT in relation to conveyancers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Registers of deeds, registers of probate, 2 and all persons employed in the office of either of said 3 persons in any capacity, are hereafter prohibited from 4 exercising any of the powers, duties or privileges per- 5 taining to conveyancers or to magistrates in the draw- 6 ing or writing of any conveyance, or the assignment 7 of any conveyance of real estate, or in taking the 8 acknowledgement of the same, and all acts and pro- 9 ceedings of the aforesaid person, done in violation of 10 the provisions of this act, shall be void, and no title 11 shall pass thereby.

SECT. 2. This act is in force when approved.
