STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize jailors to administer oaths to poor debtors and poor prisoners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Any jailor may administer all oaths required to be administered to poor debtors, on certificates of inability to support themselves in jail, and on all schedules of property required to be given by poor prisoners on their discharge from imprisonment.

SECT. 2. This act is in force when approved.
