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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

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AN ACT to authorize the taking by towns of eligible sites for the erection of soldiers' monuments thereon.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The municipal officers of cities and towns are hereby  
2 authorized to take eligible sites for the erection of  
3 soldiers' monuments thereon ; the damages therefor to  
4 be assessed and paid in the same manner as for land  
5 taken for ways, and with the same right of appeal as  
6 is given to parties aggrieved by the damages awarded  
7 for lands taken for ways.
