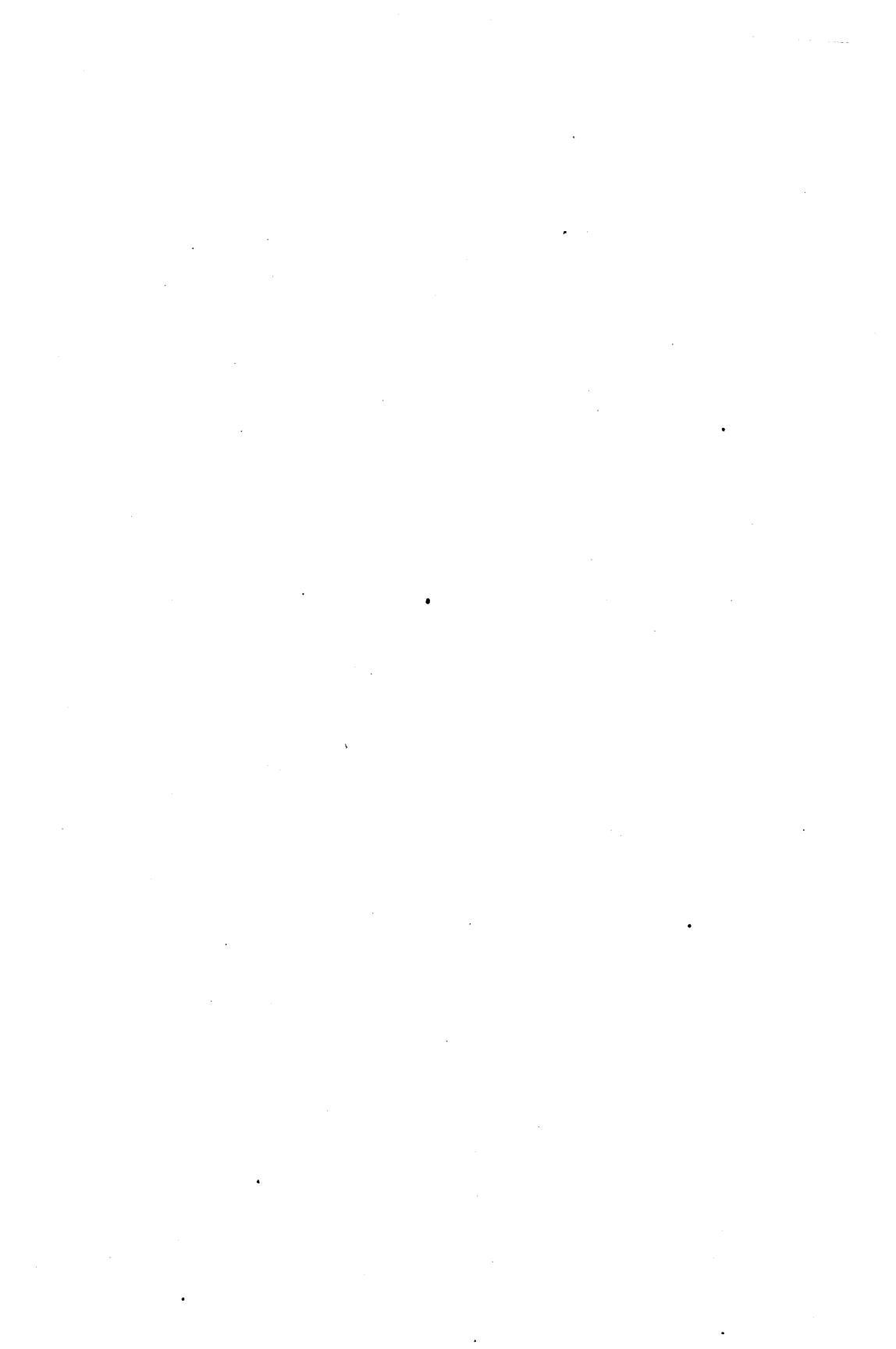
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT amendatory of chapter fifty-one of the revised statutes, relating to railroads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section three of chapter fifty-one of the revised
2 statutes of eighteen hundred seventy-one, is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the word "time," in the
4 seventh line of said section, the following: '*provided*
5 *however*, that when land is held by a tenant for life,
6 and the reversion is contingent as to the persons in
7 whom it may vest, on the termination of the life
8 estate, such fact shall be stated in the application, and
9 the commissioners shall, in addition to the notice to
10 the tenant for life, give notice by publication to all
11 others interested in such manner as they shall deem
12 proper.'
