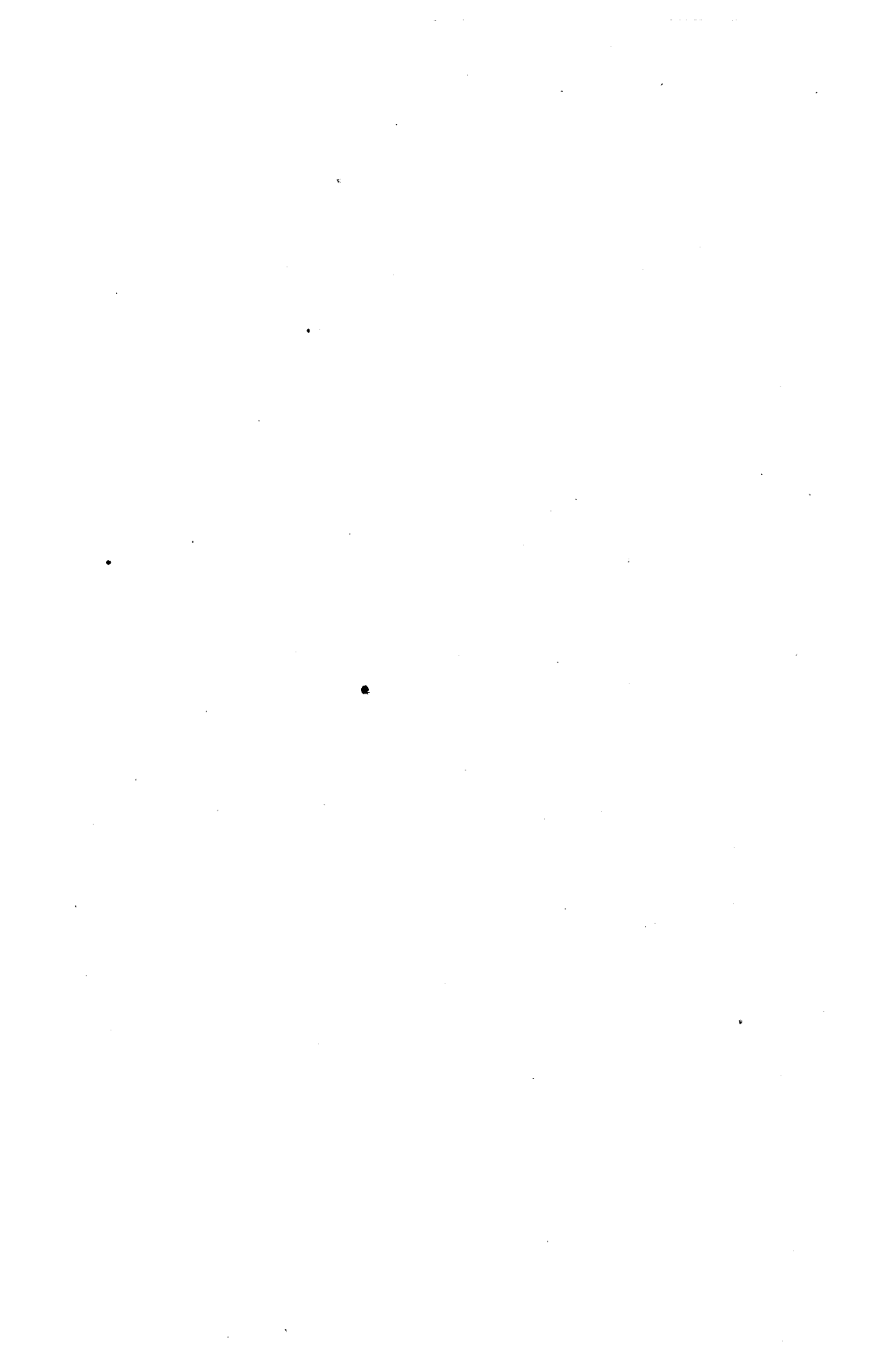
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to costs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section one hundred and four of chapter 2 eighty-two of the revised statutes, is amended, by 3 adding thereto: "if, after a verdict returned by a jury, 4 the party in whose favor the jury found, shall carry 5 the case into the law court and the decision there shall 6 be against him, he shall recover no costs subsequent 7 to the verdict, but the party prevailing in the law 8 court shall recover costs accruing after verdict."

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
