STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT regulating meetings of cities and towns, in aid of persons and corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Whenever any city or town has voted
2 at any legal meeting thereof upon any question of
3 loaning its credit to, or taking stock in, or in any way
4 on aid to any person or corporation, it shall not be
5 lawful for said city or town to vote again upon the
6 same subject, excepting only at its next annual meet-
7 ing.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
