STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT regulating railroad corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. No railroad company shall limit the
2 right of a ticket holder to any given train, but such
3 ticket holder shall have the right to travel on any train,
4 whether regular or express train, and shall have the
5 privilege of stopping at any of the stations along the
6 line of road at which such trains stop, and such ticket
7 shall be good for a passage as above for thirty days
8 from the day it was first used.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from its approval.
